



Members & Their Cars Web Page Guidelines

The Member's and Their Cars web page is to highlight the Studebakers our Chapter members own. The Tempo's Members History page focuses on the people – this web page will focus on the vehicle. This is a suggested format that I hope will help you write about your vehicle and make it easy for me to post it for you. Use only the sections you want to.

Please feel free to submit photos, digitally if you can, or printed, which will be scanned and returned to you. These could include before and after pictures, action shots of work being done, trip photos, etc. I'll make a photo gallery out of them and highlight a few shots on the page.

Introduction – include where you bought the vehicle, when and a few general notes about it.

History – You can use this section to give info about the vehicle's history, perhaps where it was first sold, previous owners, etc.

Specs & Features – engine, transmission, etc. Think of all the questions guys ask when they talk about cars.

Repairs/Improvements – tell us briefly what you've done to repair and improve the vehicle. Point form works well because it's easy to write and easy to read. When I did the Wagonaire, I listed what has been done by dividing the items into three categories, interior, body and mechanical. It seemed to help us remember what we've done to the car.

Planned Projects – Some of us have plans to do more work on our Studeys. Tell us what you still want to do. If you aren't planning anything, skip this part.

Summary – To finish off the page write a paragraph or two of where you've gone with your vehicle, tell us about a specific adventure or describe how you feel about it – anything you want to share.

A Bit About You – The final paragraph will be a short one about you as a member.

I hope this works for you. If you have any suggestions for improvement on the page, process or the website in general, please let me know.
